# HOW TO GET TO EPOA AGM IF ...











BY SHUTTLE: Every day Airport shuttles from/to Torino Airport run every 15 '/ 30'. Some trips are direct and take shorter. Single ticket price: 7,50€ (+1,00€ aboard) • Journey time: 50 mins (35' for direct lines).

IMPORTANT: Some shuttles may have a stop at "Lingotto". THAT IS NOT THE SAME as the metro station for the hotels. GET OFF at PORTA SUSA, and take the metro to Lingotto.

### ... YOU LAND AT MILANO MALPENSA (MXP)

There are several shuttle lines from Milano Malpensa Airport to Torino.

Here you find the three most convenient ones (the closest stop to the hotel).

Journey times are all around 2 hrs, tickets ~22 EUR.

**IMPORTANT:** Some shuttles may have a stop at "Lingotto". **THAT IS NOT THE SAME** as the metro station for the hotels. GET OFF at PORTA SUSA, and take the metro to Lingotto.

At Porta Susa Bus Terminal get the Metro (direction: BENGASI).

After 8 stops, get off at **LINGOTTO** station. See detailed map to the hotels.




### ... YOU LAND AT **BERGAMO ORIO AL SERIO (BGY)**

- There are some shuttle lines from Bergamo Airport to Torino. Just make sure that your stop is Torino Vittorio Emanuele (NOT Stura, NOT Lingotto). Here you have some tips to book the trip

- BY BUS + TRAIN: you can take shuttle to Milano Centrale railway station and then a train to Torino.






The fastest way is to take a bus to Milano Centrale railway station and form there take a fast train to Torino Porta Susa railway station.






### WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT **BUS/METRO TICKETS**





#### WHERE TO FIND TICKETS

You should buy the ticket **BEFORE** getting on the bus/metro.

On some buses, you can buy the tickets aboard (but cash only and NO CHANGE)

**Only in the metro** and on some (random) newer buses you can pay **contactless** with credit cards without buying the ticket.

So, it is best to buy the ticket BEFORE you get on the vehicle. You can find bus/metro tickets:

- in almost all tobacconists
- at automatic machines in metro stations
- electronic tickets can be bought by the app GTT TO MOVE (Android only, sorry)

#### **TICKET FARES**

Single ride ticket is valid for 100 mins. on any bus and ONE metro ride and has to be validated on the vehicle.

- ► City ticket (single ride) € 1,70
- ► MultiCity (6 rides)- € 10,00
- Daily (unlimited rides within end of daily service) € 4,00
  If bought through ToMove app, it costs € 3,00 and can be used within 365 days of the time of purchase.
- MultiDaily 7 € 17,50 from the first validation until the end of the service for 7 days, even non-consecutive.
- ► Special "Tour" ticket valid for 48/72 hours €7,50/10,00

You can check the ride timetable of as specific bus stop via **Telegram**. Open the app, search for **@gttorari** and input the bus stop number (it is usually printed on the line board at the bus stop). You will get a message with the rides.
