

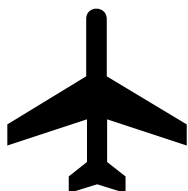

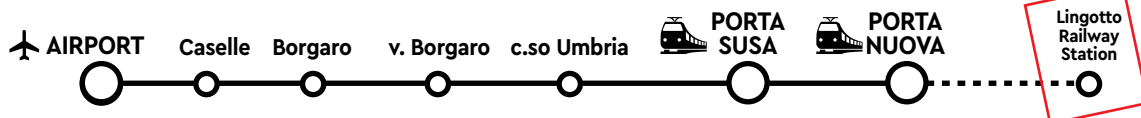

... YOU LAND AT TORINO AIRPORT (TRN)



- **BY SHUTTLE:** Every day Airport shuttles from/to Torino Airport run every 15 ' / 30'. Some trips are direct and take shorter. Single ticket price: 7,50€ (+1,00€ aboard) • Journey time: 50 mins (35' for direct lines).

IMPORTANT: Some shuttles may have a stop at "Lingotto". **THAT IS NOT THE SAME** as the metro station for the hotels. GET OFF at PORTA SUSA, and take the metro to Lingotto.

- alternatively, you can take a taxi. The price for a ride to LINGOTTO is fixed at 41 EUR. You can find them just outside the arrivals area or call one at **+39 011 5730** or **+39 011 5737**. All credit cards **must** be accepted, if you want to use them.

- It is usually more convenient to get off at Porta Susa Airport Bus Terminal rather than Porta Nuova one. The station is usually less crowded. In any case, get the Metro (**direction: BENGASI**). After 8 stops (5 if you take the metro at Porta Susa), get off at **LINGOTTO** station. See detailed map to the hotels.



... YOU LAND AT MILANO MALPENSA (MXP)

- There are several shuttle lines from Milano Malpensa Airport to Torino. Here you find the three most convenient ones (the closest stop to the hotel). Journey times are all around 2 hrs, tickets ~22 EUR.

IMPORTANT: Some shuttles may have a stop at "Lingotto". **THAT IS NOT THE SAME** as the metro station for the hotels. GET OFF at PORTA SUSA, and take the metro to Lingotto.



- Alternatively, you can take shuttle/train to Milano Centrale railway station and a train to Torino (see: ... if you arrive by train).



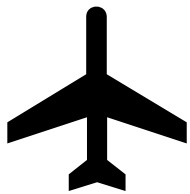

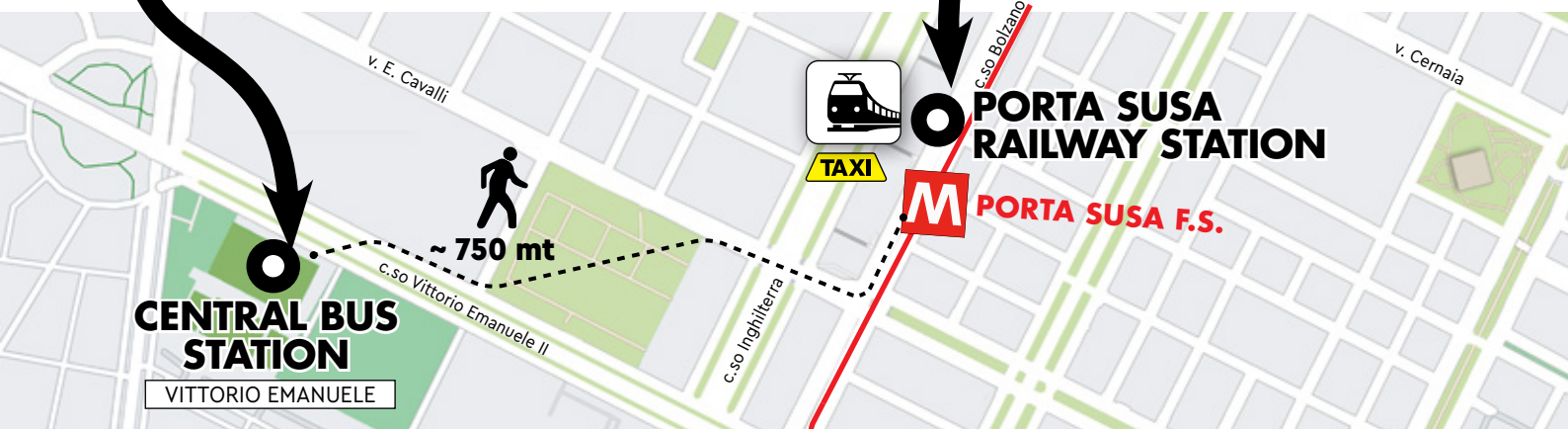

- BY BUS + TRAIN: you can take shuttle to Milano Centrale railway station and then a train to Torino.

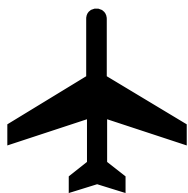

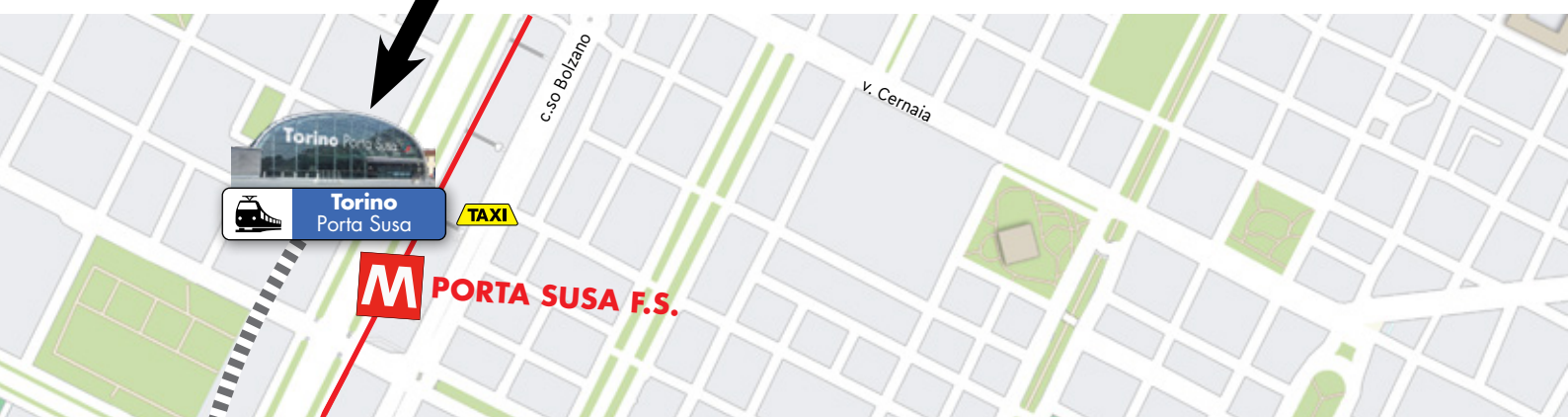
... YOU LAND AT MILANO LINATE (LIN)

The fastest way is to take a bus to Milano Centrale railway station and from there take a fast train to Torino Porta Susa railway station.

Fast trains are **FRECCIAROSSA**, run by TRENITALIA, or **.italo** trains.



(All fast trains via **MILANO** stop at Porta Susa and proceed to Porta Nuova)

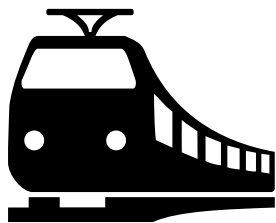

Fast trains via **PARIS/LYON** stop **ONLY** at Porta Susa
All fast trains via **MILANO** stop at Porta Susa and proceed to Porta Nuova

stop **ONLY** at Porta Nuova

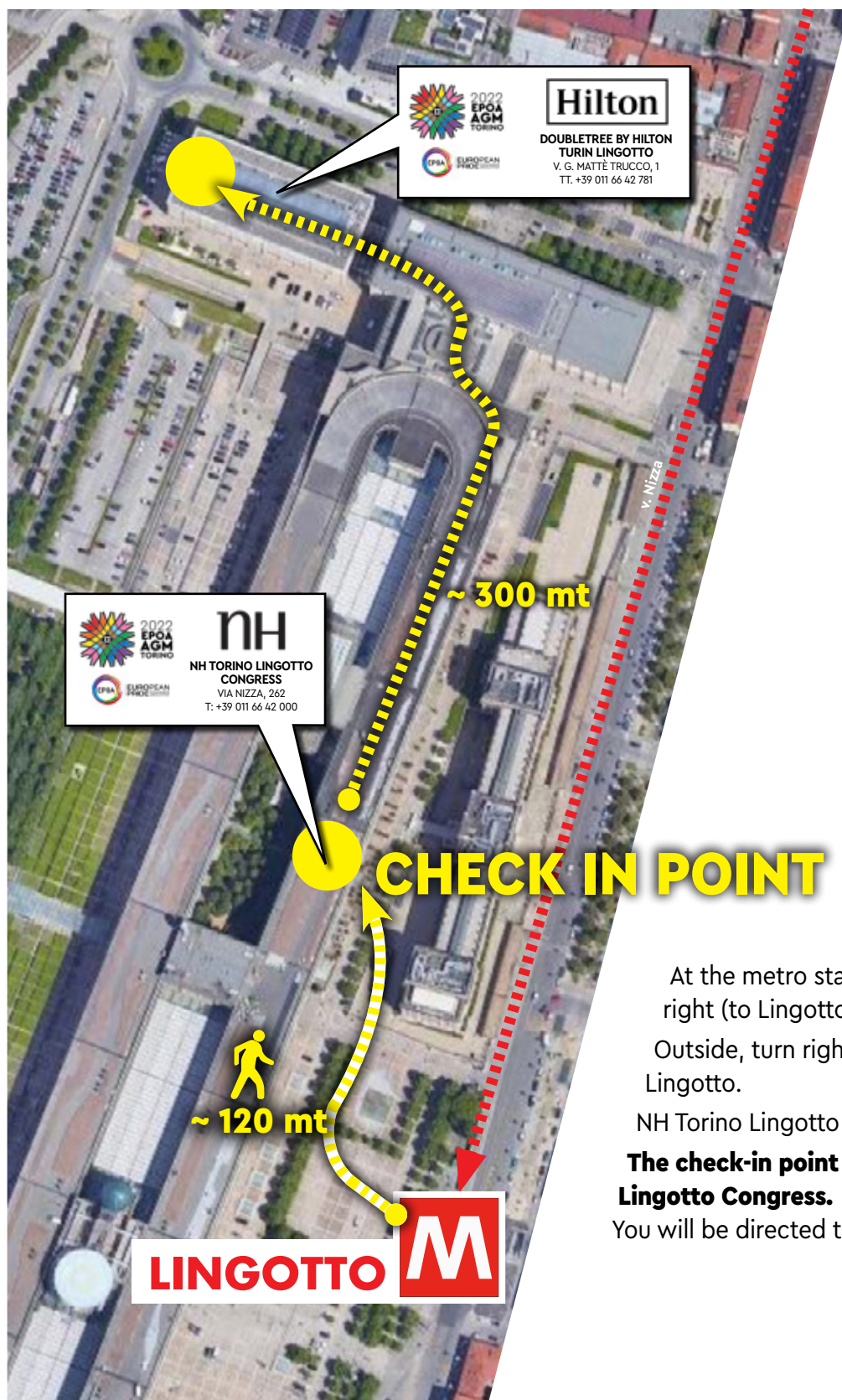

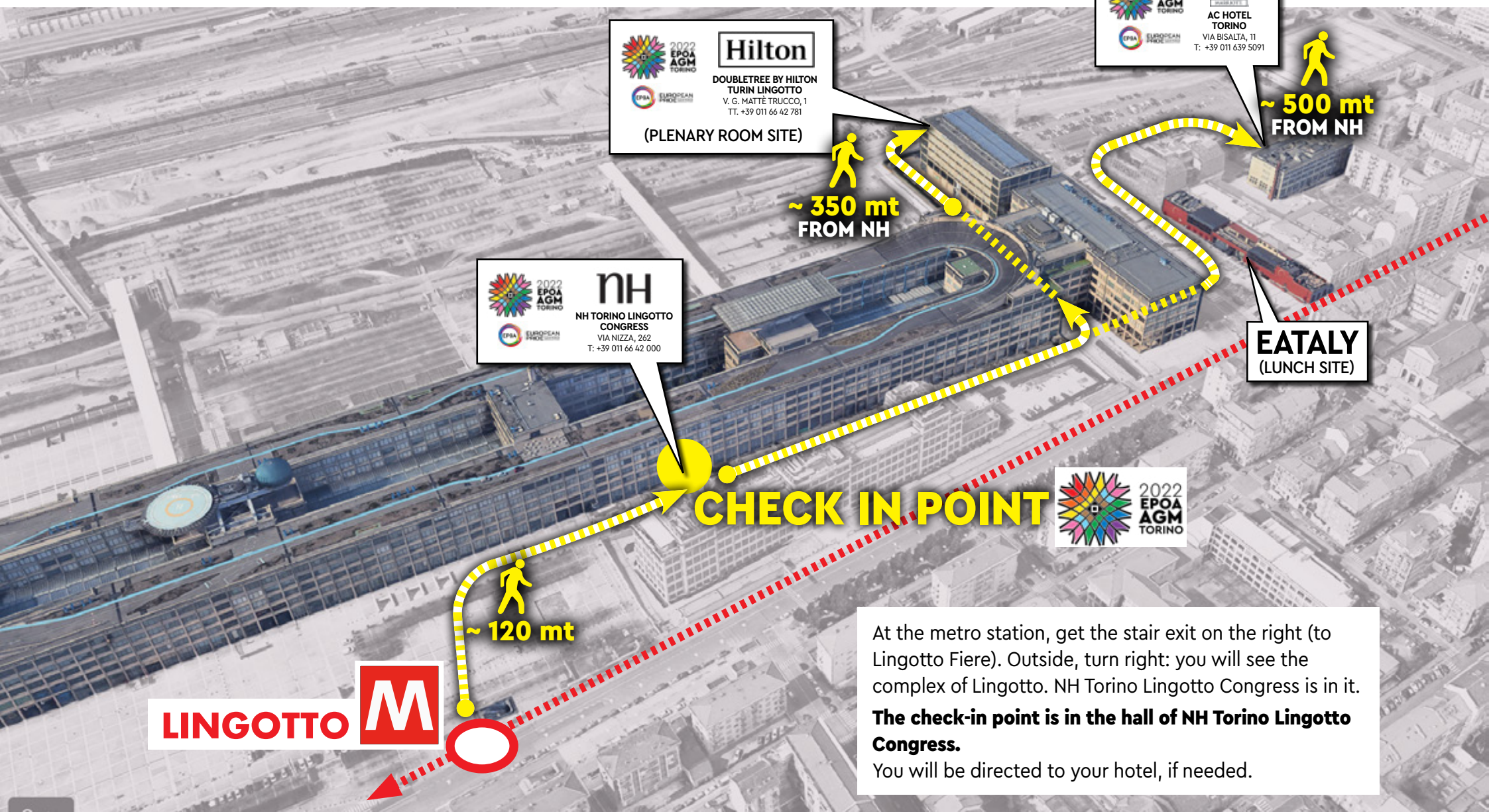

CHECK IN POINT



At the metro station, get the stair exit on the right (to Lingotto Fiere). Outside, turn right: you will see the complex of Lingotto. NH Torino Lingotto Congress is in it.

WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT BUS/METRO TICKETS



WHERE TO FIND TICKETS

You should buy the ticket **BEFORE** getting on the bus/metro.

On some buses, you can buy the tickets aboard (but cash only and NO CHANGE)

Only in the metro and on some (random) newer buses you can pay **contactless** with credit cards without buying the ticket.

So, it is best to buy the ticket **BEFORE** you get on the vehicle. You can find bus/metro tickets:

- in almost all tobacconists
- at automatic machines in **metro** stations
- electronic tickets can be bought by the app GTT TO MOVE (**Android only**, sorry)

TICKET FARES

Single ride ticket is valid for 100 mins. on any bus and ONE metro ride and has to be validated on the vehicle.

- **City ticket** (single ride) – € 1,70
- **MultiCity** (6 rides)- € 10,00
- **Daily** (unlimited rides within end of daily service) – € 4,00

If bought through ToMove app, it costs € 3,00 and can be used within 365 days of the time of purchase.

- **MultiDaily 7** – € 17,50
from the first validation until the end of the service for 7 days, even non-consecutive.
- **Special "Tour"** ticket valid for 48/72 hours – €7,50/10,00

WHEN IS NEXT RIDE?

You can check the ride timetable of a specific bus stop via **Telegram**. Open the app, search for **@gttorari** and input the bus stop number (it is usually printed on the line board at the bus stop). You will get a message with the rides.
